

Simba

South Africans were first introduced to the Simba chip way back in 1957. It all started with Leon Greyvenstein's idea to expand his family's business, which included his mom Elizabeth's much-loved Ouma rusks. Since then, South Africans have enjoyed Simba chips for generations at every sports match, birthday party and many movie nights.

Amarula

Made from sugar, cream and real marula fruit matured for two years in French oak, the process is uniquely South African. Every year, the company negotiates with local chiefs for the price of the fruit that grows wild in the Mpumalanga region. It is then harvested by the local community.

Ariel

Ariel detergents arrived in South Africa in 2013 and immediately became a favourite in Mzansi. They won our hearts right away when they gathered over a 1000 people to wash clothes simultaneously to set a new Guinness World Record before donating the clothes to the South African Red Cross Society. Their innovative products save us all time and hassle by lifting every stain left by life's thrills and spills.

Bic

This iconic brand has a long history in South Africa. It all began in 1958 when Bic acquired Biro Swan Ltd, a UK company with activities in the so-called "sterling zone", which South Africa was part of. At the start of the 70s, the company launched their pocket lighters and shavers, supported by memorable advertising.

McCain

The family-owned Canadian companu came to South Africa in 2000 and instantly found a place in our homes. Their iconic 2017 "Thank you mom" advertisement campaign featured three South Africans and warmed the hearts of the entire country. Their range of frozen vegetables are now so popular, it is said one in every three chips eaten globally is a McCain chip.
